



Walk Trail Information

Distance: 5.2 kms

Time: 1 ½ - 2 hours

Grade: 2 - 3

Location: Start point is end of Helena Valley Road, **Helena Valley**.

Description: Moderately easy loop in the **Beelu National Park**. There are a few steep parts, lovely views of the pipe head dam and beautiful orchids late spring. This walk trail has a minimum amount of signage. This walk is easy to follow.

Trail Notes:

Start point: End of sealed section of Helena Valley Road.

- 1. Take the left fork. The first part of the track is following the unmade Helena Valley Road.
- 2. Cross a dry water course with a steel bridge and a locked gate.
- 3. Continue on the track, good views of Pipe head Dam.
- 4. At this point, veer away from the river and head uphill.
- 5. At the T-Junction, take the right fork at the Shire of Kalamunda walk trail sign. This is the furthest point of the walk.
- 6. A track converges from the left.
- 7. Ignore track to the right.
- 8. Cross an open area and through the white gate.
- 9. Rejoin main road and turn left. Return to the start point.
