


Camel Farm to Hewett's Hill

- To help reduce the spread of *Phytophthora Dieback* along this walk trail and in the surrounding area:
- Don't spread soil or mud around bushland, in particular during spring & autumn;
 - Stick to tracks & paths;
 - Observe signage in your local bushland reserve and stay out of quarantined areas in bushland.

Bibbulmun Track - Camel Farm to Hewett's Hill & Return

Walk Trail Information

Distance: 5 kms

Time: 1 ½ hours

Grade: 2 - 3

Location: Paull's Valley Road, **Hackett's Gully**, approximately 15 minutes from Kalamunda in the **Beelu National Park**.

Description: A pleasant walk through mixed hills forest and some plantation forest.

The trail markers are the Bibbulmun Track markers



Trail Notes:

Start point: The parking area at the Camel Farm.

1. Follow the road outside the Camel Farm fence in an easterly direction.
2. At the end of the fence veer left and follow Bibbulmun Track signs.
3. At the crossroads, continue straight through following the Bibbulmun Track signs.
4. Another crossroads, continue straight through.
5. Cross a sealed road and continue on the track.
6. Cross a small gravel road and continue straight ahead.
7. Another gravel road, cross this and go straight ahead.
8. Cross over disused road and continue straight ahead.
9. Turn off to Hewett's Hill. Follow the sign uphill to the hut.
10. Hewitt's Hut, the first Hut on Bibbulmun Track. There is usually water in the tank. From the Hut, return on the same track to the start point. The track is marked in both directions.
